If you are unable to keep your appointment, **call** the office at least **24 hours in advance** to cancel the procedure. Note: Any less time to cancel or reschedule may result in a charge for set up, boarding and rescheduling.

2 wks. Prior	1. <u>If you take Diet pills</u> not limited to but including, <u>Phenteramine</u> (Phen-Phen Diet Pills), stop this and any type of diet medication 2 weeks prior to procedure.
1 Wk. Prior	1. DO NOT EAT foods containing small seeds (nuts, tomatoes, cucumbers, rye, popcorn, sesame, caraway, poppy and grapes). 2. Stop Iron, 1 week before your procedure.
7-5-2 days prior	 3. If you take the following medications, stop according to medical guidelines. If you are a heart patient and taking these medications, consult your cardiologist prior to stopping. Stop Effient (prasugrel) 7 days prior. Stop Coumadin (warfarin), Plavix (clopidogrel) & Brilinta (ticagrelor) 5 days prior. Stop Pradaxa (dabigatran), Xarelto (rivaroxaban), Eliquis (apixaban) & Savaysa (edoxaban) 2 days prior.
DAY BEFORE	 Clear liquid dinner: water, broth, pop, fruits, juices, black coffee, tea and jello. At 6 P.M. take 3-4 tablespoons of Milk of Magnesia, followed by two 8 oz. glasses of water. Do not eat until after your procedure.
Day Of Procedure	 Between <u>5 & 6 a.m</u>, on the <u>morning</u> of your examination, take your <u>heart and/or blood pressure medication</u> with a small sip of water. If your procedure is after 12 noon, you may have a clear liquid breakfast. Nothing by mouth 6 hrs prior to procedure. One hour before appt. use as directed <u>One FLEET ENEMA</u> (green/white box). <u>Bring someone with you</u> to stay during your procedure and take you home. If you arrive alone, your examination will be cancelled. Please <u>be on time</u>. If you are late, you will be the cause of major delays for all other patients' under-going similar examinations. Furthermore, if you are late, your examination may be cancelled and so that the schedule for other patients can be maintained.
After Procedure	After you are <u>discharged</u> , return home. <u>Do not drive</u> , operate machinery, or drink alcoholic beverages for <u>18-24 hours</u> . If you have any complications (vomiting, abdominal pain, tenderness, fever or bleeding) after returning home, call the office at 248-662-4110, after 4 p.m. call the answering service at 866-830-7280
